

POWER SUPPLY FOR COMMERCIAL JOB SITE

Construction Job Site, Illinois

As construction projects begin, one of the first needs on site is a job trailer, quickly followed by power needs. That power is needed five to six days a week, sometimes more, which makes fueling and maintenance essential for the generator. This is where Garrett McKenzie comes in.

THE SITUATION

As construction was set to break ground, the contractor requested a job trailer fully equipped with power. The generator would operate at triple shift to maintain heating inside the trailer during winter months. A fuel cell was also delivered to maintain generator operation.

THE RESPONSE

Aligning with the construction schedule and trailer delivery, Garrett McKenzie arrived with the generator and fuel cell on an agreed date. An electrician connected the unit to breaker, and a GM technician connected the generator and fuel cell and then powered the unit. In case of issues, construction staff were shown unit operating procedures by a GM technician.

THE EXECUTION

The generator and fuel cell would remain on site for many months, including through the coldest months of the year. Regular fueling of the fuel cell and preventive maintenance on the generator were scheduled and handled entirely by GM technicians.

THE RESULT

The 40 kW generator and 500 gallon fuel cell remain on the job site today. The job trailer is heated, with the trailer lights and other appliances running from the power supplied by the rental units, helping to keep the construction site working as planned throughout the winter months.

Rental generator and fuel cell keep construction site trailer operational.
