

JOB SITE POWER FOR A PROJECT TRAILER IN MILWAUKEE, WI

Construction Trailer, Wisconsin

As construction was set to begin in Milwaukee, WI, the general contractor did not yet have any electrical service on site and requested temporary power to help the project team get started. Garrett McKenzie supplied a generator, fuel cell, and maintenance.

THE SITUATION

With a new construction project set to begin, a general contractor was having their job site trailer delivered. With the local power service not scheduled for completion for a few months, the GC and electrical contractors contacted Garrett McKenzie for a generator and regular service.

THE RESPONSE

After determining the power needs and delivery date, Garrett McKenzie worked with the GC and electrical contractor on site. Once schedules were confirmed, the generator, fuel cell and connection gear were loaded and set for delivery on the date needed. Given the delivery area where the equipment was to be placed, one rollback truck with a trailer hitch was all that was

THE EXECUTION

Arranging for the electrical contractor to meet the delivery of equipment, the generator and other rental equipment was delivered. The generator was easily positioned and a fuel cell was placed nearby. After the cable was run, an electrician connected the generator to the breaker and the power was all set.

THE RESULT

The generator and fuel cell remained on site for roughly six weeks. During that time, Garrett McKenzie performed regular maintenance on the generator and also managed fuel delivery on regular intervals. Once the permanent power was active on site, all equipment was called off rent and removed.

Generator, fuel cell and maintenance keeps job trailer operational.
